


**BCA TO HAVE BOOTH AND AUTHOR SIGNINGS AT TUCSON FESTIVAL OF BOOKS



The **Border Community Alliance (BCA) Booth #320** and the **Nuestras Raíces stage** are centrally located on the **University of Arizona Mall**, situated on the south side of the main walkway. From **Old Main**, you can reach them by walking directly east along **University Boulevard** (keeping to the right/south side of the mall). The booth is positioned near the **Nuestras Raíces stage**, which serves as a landmark for regional culture and community exhibitors.
